#1. What seems to stand out to you about the passage? What are the most important details of what the author says?

- Take a look at Paul's talk in the synagogue (v. 16-41), are there any "hinge points" in his speech? At what points does Paul seem to change the direction of his discussion?
- How does Paul respond to the "jealous Jews (v. 45)? How does this affect our understanding of why Luke included this story in the book of Acts?

#2. - What is the main point of the passage? Why did God include this passage in His book?

#3. How should the truth of this passage affect your life? How does God push us to live differently because of what is expressed?

#4. In what ways does the passage speak to our need?

#5. How does the passage draw us back to Jesus' work on the cross? How does Jesus seem sweeter to you because of what's written?
