#1. What seems to stand out to you about the passage? What are the most important details of what the author says?

- What is the gist of the argument discussed between the party of the Pharisees and Peter/Paul in 15:6-11? Why is this important
- What is the disagreement between Paul and Barnabas in 15:36-41? How is this different than that of 15:6-11?

#2. What is the main point of the passage? Why did God include this passage in His book?

#3. How should the truth of this passage affect your life? How does God push us to live differently because of what is expressed?

#4. In what ways does the passage speak to our need?

#5. How does the passage draw us back to Jesus' work on the cross? How does Jesus seem sweeter to you because of what's written?
